Criteria

The nominee will:

- Demonstrate passion, dedication and commitment to understanding and applying leadership concepts and values
- Demonstration of making a difference within his/her organization with qualitative results in improving services
- Dedication to profession development through the active involvement within other professional or community organizations and/or LeadingAge Ohio

Application Questions for Emerging Leader Award

Q1: Summarize the key points of this award nomination. In a nutshell, what do you most want the judges to know about this nominee, including how long the nominee has worked for the organization? (200-word limit)

Q2: What lessons do the nominee's practices offer that others can learn from to expand excellence in the aging services field. Provide examples. (600-word limit)

Q3: Describe the nominee's growth within senior care organizations such as LeadingAge Ohio. (600-word limit)

Q4: Describe the nominee's work and how it demonstrates success in understanding and applying leadership concepts and values. Provide examples of improved outcomes and how they are measured. (600-word limit)

Q5: Describe with examples the nominee's accomplishments in the leadership development of others. What makes this person an outstanding mentor worthy of recognition. Provide examples. (600-word limit)

Q6: Provide a brief description of the nominated organization's mission, size, scope of services, and persons served. (200-word limit)
